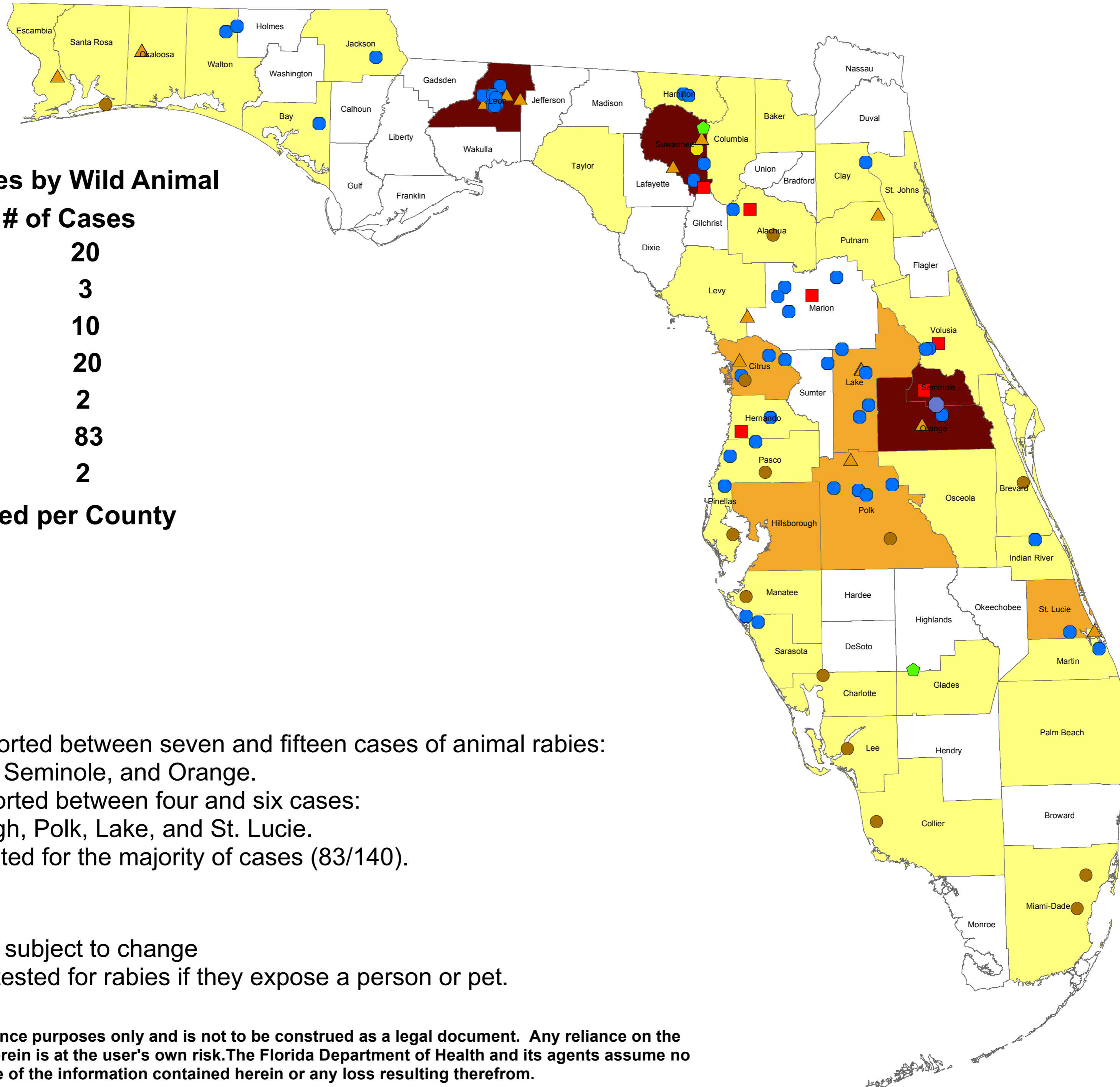


# Reported Animal Rabies in Florida

Four counties reported between seven and fifteen cases of animal rabies: Leon, Suwannee, Seminole, and Orange.

Five counties reported between four and six cases: Citrus, Hillsborough, Polk, Lake, and St. Lucie.

Raccoons accounted for the majority of cases (83/140).
