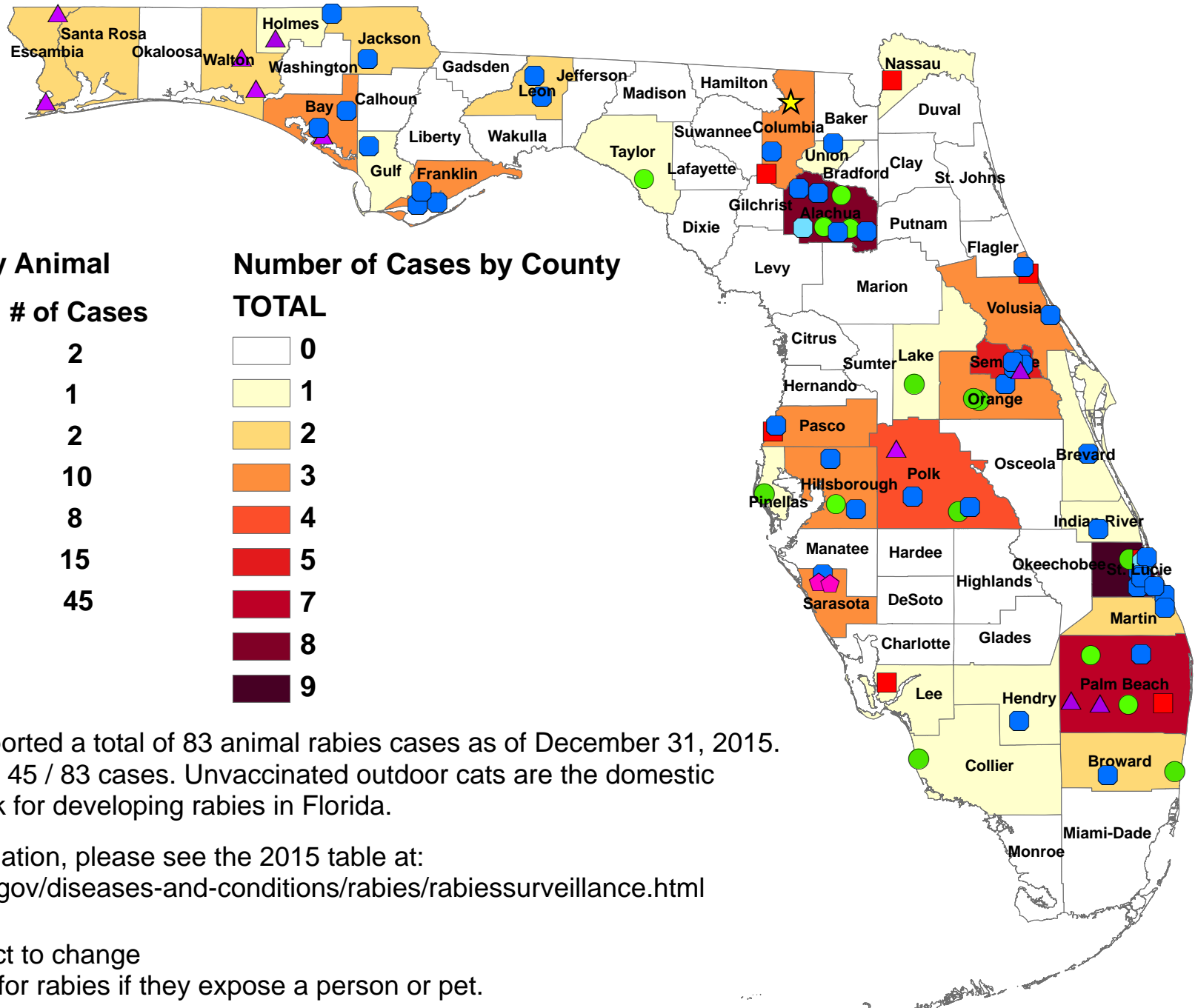




Reported Animal Rabies in Florida

Thirty-three counties reported a total of 83 animal rabies cases as of December 31, 2015. Raccoons accounted for 45 / 83 cases. Unvaccinated outdoor cats are the domestic animal particularly at risk for developing rabies in Florida.
